We are happy to have this season which calls us back to our Almighty Father. What a joy to know that our Creator is always ready to welcome us back whenever we repent and come back to Him.



Thank you for your consideration in this project.



■ We congratulate **Sr. Renata Onyego**, who received a Bachelor of Science in Early Care and Early Childhood Studies (BS).


Our Deepest Condolences... to members who lost their beloved ones

WATER FILTERS

With the help of you, our donors, water filters were distributed to women in an area that had no good source of clean water, This will save many families from sickness and death due to water borne diseases. Below, is a note from Sr. Bene, who led the delegate and presented the workshop.

Happy New Year Sr.

How are you and the Sisters? I hope good. My regards to all of them. These are the pictures of our Water woman trip to Mbeke Ishieke in Effium, Abakaliki in Ebonyi State. We were five in number that went. We gathered them together and gave the necessary instructions, then practiced use of the filter before them and appointed some to do so. We divided them into groups and registered them. The women that came were many and we had only the 60 water filters you sent to us. Sr. Pet took three families with small children who are very much in need of clean water. We were able to give only 55 people because the remaining two were unable to upload. I have informed Sr. Barbara and she asked me to send her the number. The women were happy because we sent someone to go to their stream to fetch the dirty water that they drink. We were able to filter the water and it was clear and sparkling. They could not believe. It seemed a miracle which brought them joy. Those that did not get a filter were requesting their own. We wished we had more to give. However, we asked each of the women who were lucky to get one, to help filter for another four women with families especially little children. They promised to do as we instructed them.

We ourselves were happy to carry out this project and we will be happy to do more if you send us more filters. There is really a great need.
