Then the certified hunter remembers the Sisters and brings them part of his prey. The Sisters prefer when it's already prepared and



On June 18th, straight from the airport, we went to see Bishop John Persud who is presently overseeing the dioceses of Mandeville and Montego Bay. Discussions were held, evaluations and promises were made, and appreciations were exchanged.

Then we left for Savana La Mar where the Sisters reside. Heat and mosquitoes were not friendly. But the Missionary spirit of the Sisters was unbreakable. We met with their landlord, pastors and parishioners. Each of the three Sisters is in charge of two parishes. We attended masses in two different parishes and a small welcome reception for us took place at Mary Gate of Heaven Catholic Church in Negril, Jamaica. The people's appreciation of the Sisters was very moving. We thanked the Lord for His steadfast Love.

On June 20th, we drove down to our community in Kingston archdiocese. While there, like other places, we were welcomed by the friends of the Sisters and their parishioners. We met with Most Rev. Kenneth Richards, Archbishop of Kingston, pastors, and some of the people the Sisters work and minister to. St. Joseph Roman Catholic Church held a special reception and we helped in presenting awards to some very active and committed parishioners. There, Sisters were among those called upon to present awards to the students of their catechism and formation classes. Those who have been helped in different ways by our Development Ministry came and expressed their gratitude. We also visited a monument for reggae icon, Bob Marley.



HAITI NATIONAL CATHOLIC SCHOOL

In Haiti, all the catholic secondary and primary schools celebrate their existence and feast day on Ascention Day, which is celebrated by every catholic school nation-wide, said Sr. Chukwuemeka Uduji. This event was hosted by a school that is run by the Daughters of Divine Love in La Croix, Haiti. Sr. Chukwuemeka, the head and her team worked very hard for the success of the event.

Every year we prepare children and adults for Holy communion in the school and parish. This year, 11 children were prepared, and two adults who left their communion years because they did not marry in the church. Many years after their husbands died, they wanted to repent and come back to communion. We take our time to catechize them before they are admitted to receive communion again, said Sr. Chukwuemeka Uduji.
