PRIVILEGE AND GOD'S FAVORS TOOK US TO PILGRIMAGE

Marilyn, in honor of late Fr. John, was gracious to pay for Srs. Victoria Oleka and myself, Sr. MaryPaul Asoegwu, to go on pilgrimage to Italy. Luckily, the Good Shepherd Travel Agency who planned the pilgrimage set it from October 6 to 16, 2025. Unknowingly to them, it fell during the period of the Jubilee for the Religious. We attended masses said by Pope Leo the XIV twice. One of the pilgrims from our group held up a poster saying: "Pope Leo XIV favorite childhood candy" and had a box of wrapped marshmallows. Funny enough, that drew the Pope's attention and he smiled as he passed by in his Pope mobile. The lady threw the box and one of the men following the Pope picked it up and they continued without stopping. We laughed and laughed but were a bit disappointed because he did not stop for he was really close.

The pilgrimage took us to all the four basilicas and more in Rome. The Feast of the Dedication of John Lateran Basilica brought good memories, knowing I was in this Basilica last month. We went to the Abbeys of Saints Benedict and Scholastic in Monte Casino; Padre Pio in San Giovanni, Rotondo; St. Francis of Assisi, St. Clare; Lanciano (the place of the First Eucharistic Miracle), and Orvieto (the place of the Second Eucharistic Miracle).

wine, and receiving many blessings; it was hectic, but joyous. It was clear that we were there as pilgrims and not as tourists.

of these places. Sr. Vick did the same. In some places, we deliberately prayed together for our donors.
